WHY A CAPITAL CAMPAIGN?



We are thankful that our church has experienced tremendous growth. As we continue to grow, it has become clear that we must expand our physical space.





MESSAGE FROM PASTOR PAUL

One of my favorite conversations in the Bible is between Nehemiah and King Artaxerxes. Nehemiah felt compelled to help the people of Jerusalem by completing a significant building project: a wall around the entire city. When the King asked Nehemiah, "What is it that you want?", Nehemiah immediately responded by saying, "Send me, that I may rebuild it." I love that response! Nehemiah understood that in order to complete such an important project, he would need help from the King and the people living in Jerusalem. Yet his immediate response was to look first to the sacrifice he must make himself, so he said to the King, "Send me; I'm all in!"



This fall, Christ Community Church plans to undertake its own significant building project. The project has a twofold purpose: to help nourish and build the faith of our church body and to supply and strengthen the physical and spiritual needs of our beloved city. As you learn more, I hope that your first response will be like Nehemiah's, "Send me; I'm all in!" It will take all of us to complete such an ambitious project, and my prayer is that each one of us will start by asking the King of Kings how we can play a significant and sacrificial role.
